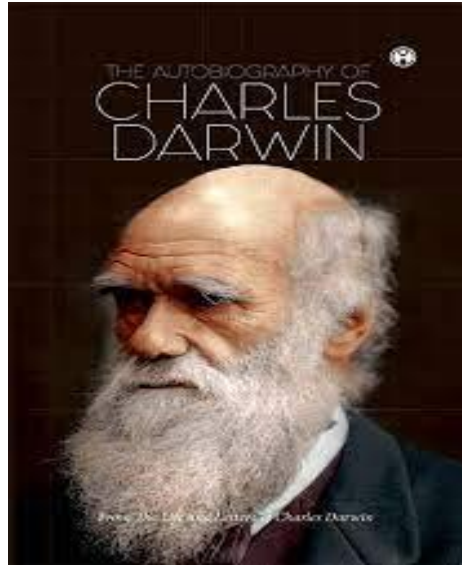

Father of Physiology

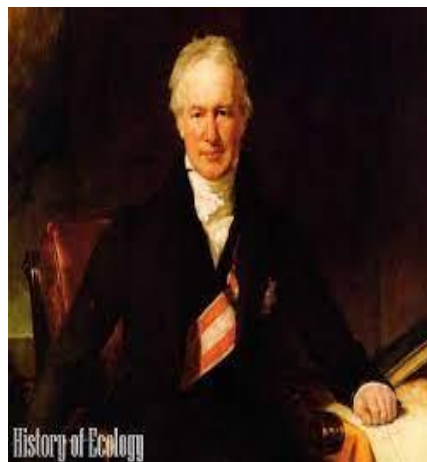
“Science increases our power in proportion as it lowers our pride.”

“Love releases incredible energy that promotes the biochemistry of healing”

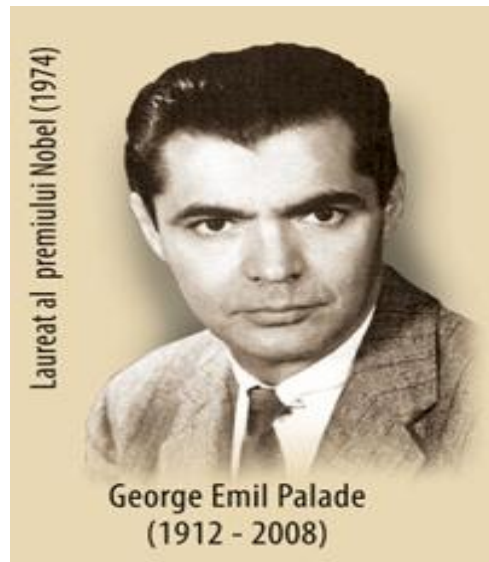


Watson and Crick with their DNA Model

Watson {April 6, 1928}

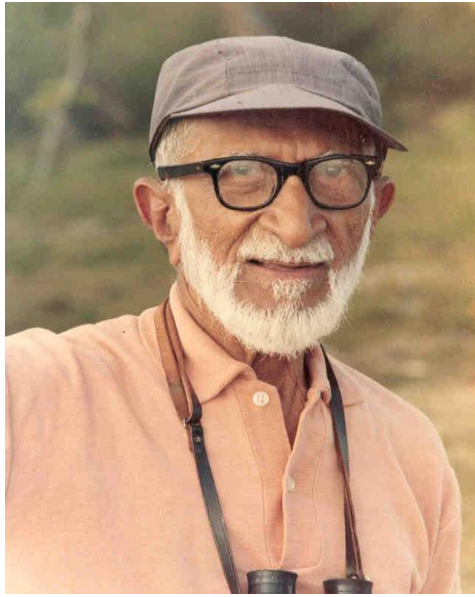
