ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admissions are made on merit basis as per the rules, regulations and norms of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad, and Government notifications.

Admission Guideline

- Application for admission to the college should be made on a prescribed admission form by all the students including those who were in this college during the previous year. This is to be done immediately after the declaration of the result of the pertinent examination of the previous year.
- The prescribed form and prospectus can be obtained from the College Office. The admission form, completed in all respects and accompanied by requisite documents should be submitted to the college after the declaration of the result of the qualifying examination. The list of requisite document to be attached to the admission form is described in the next section. The admission forms which are incomplete or incorrectly filled or submitted late will be summarily rejected.
- Out of the total available seats for each stream 50% seats are reserved for those belonging to Jain Minority Community. Reservation for the remaining 50% seats will be follows: SC-13%, ST-7%, VJ-3%, NT1 -2.5%, NT2- 3.5%, NT3- 2%, OBC-19%, SBC-2%. Reservation is applicable only for Maharashtra domicile SC, ST, DT, NT, OBC, SBC categories as per the Government of Maharashtra resolutions of [The students migrating from other states will not be entitled to the concessions/benefits available to the SC/ST/DT/NT/SBC and OBC students of the Maharashtra State.]
- Non-Creamy Layer Certificate is necessary for DT/NT/OBC/SBC category candidates at the time of final admission. If the candidate is not domicile of Maharashtra State then he / she should submit the domicile certificate.
- Candidates from Maharashtra state belonging to SC/ST/DT/NT/OBC must submit the caste certificate. Three percent seats of total sanctioned intake capacity shall be reserved. For physically challenged candidates. Out of these seats, 1% each is sanctioned for Blind, Deaf & Dumb, and orthopaedic disorder.
- The admission forms of the students who have secured admission on the basis of merit list will be signed by the appropriate authorities. The grant of admission to the class rests solely with college authorities.
- The admission granted by the college is provisional until it is confirmed by the appropriate authorities.

- It should be noted that the fees paid will be treated as deposit till the admission is confirmed by the authorities. If later on, the admission is rejected by the University or cancelled by the student, the fees will be refunded with deductions as per the rules of the Education Department.
- Students eligible for the first year of degree courses must have passed the H. S. C. examination or an examination recognized as equivalent with subject as may as specified by the university in relevant streams.
- Photocopies of the following documents duly attested by a competent authority should be submitted along with the admission form filled by the applicant in neat the legible handwriting.
 - ✓ [i] Statement of Marks (Last qualifying examination)
 - ✓ [ii] Statement of Marks (Last qualifying if statement of marks does not indicate clearly class / percentage of marks obtained by the student in the relevant subjects)
 - ✓ [iii] Migration Certificate (original) (if applicable) (original will not be returned)
 - ✓ [iv] Transfer Certificate(if applicable). (Original will not be returned)
 - ✓ [v] Written statement regarding gap in education and / or change of name (in the admission process by the college / university).
- All the original documents except leaving certificate / transfer certificate / migration certificate / gap certificate, etc. will the returned to the concerned student after the same are stamped by the college for scrutiny.

FREESHIP / CONCESSION in FEES

The following remission / concession in fees is available in the college.

- Students whose parents - guardians have an income less than Rs. 1 00000/- per annum are eligible for E.B.C. Concession is provided for the students domicile of Maharashtra. The students coming from other states are not eligible for EBC. E.B.C. forms should be submitted in the College Office in duplicate duly filled in all respects, signed and stamped by a Special Executive Magistrate / Officer at the time of admission.
- Freeship for the Sons / Daughters of Primary School Teachers.
- Government of India Scholarship is awarded to the B.C. students. The students applying for the Government of India B.C. scholarship for the last academic year should submit their forms duly filled, in all respects within 30 days of the admission or before 31st July or whichever is earlier. No application will be accepted after 31st July.

CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION

The candidate cancelling his / her confirmed admission will be entitled to receive the refund of fees after deducting the amounts as indicated below except otherwise prescribed by the State Govt. / University / Competent Authority.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

Student Council :

It is constituted as per the Maharashtra University ACT 1994, section 40 and activities for the welfare of students. There is a democratically elected student's council in the college. All regular student of college are the members of the student council which function under a cell. The council of the student regulates the activities including election and formation of the executive committees of the council. The council is pledged to uphold the dignity and high academic ideas for the college.

Gymkhana :

Gymnasium facilities are available to students who are more active in sports. A special attention for indoor and outdoor games is provided. We have established dominance in Basketball And Volleyball, Chess and Cricket tournaments. We conduct Yoga camp and also encourage female student for their participation order to inculcate the habit of physical exercise among the student. Facilities for extracurricular activities fitness center, 200 mtr running track, ground for outdoor sport like cricket, football, volleyball, kabaddi, kho-kho are available. We have large playground for Handball, volleyball, badminton, kabbadi, and cricket practices. Sports students are given preference for admission. Scholarship for sport students as per the recommendation of the physical director is available. Student participate free of cost. We host tournaments in campus on behalf of university and other sports associations.

Library :

The Library is centrally placed and easily accessible. It has a collection of (10,000) books. It Subscribes more than 20 National and International journals. Sufficient numbers of books are purchased every year to update the library and satisfy the growing needs of the students. Reference Book, encyclopaedias, books for competitive examination, newspapers and newspaper clippings are available for the students. The library is partially computerized. There is a separate reading hall for the student with essential amenities. The book bank has been instituted for the needy and hard-working students. - Not to sit on the parapet walls and steps.
- To switch off the Cell Phones during Class Hours, Laboratory Sessions, Library.
- To be punctual for all theory and laboratory classes as well as for guest lectures and meetings.
- To stay till the end of the Meeting Seminars.
- To respect to prayer song, National Anthem, faculty, staff and other elders.
- To extend good hospitality during programs.
- To maintain a cordial relationship with others especially maintaining harmony in a multi cultural environment.
- To Conserve energy by switching off fans and lights when not in use.

Attendance :

Ragging is any conduct by any students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness, fresher or any student or including in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension there in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act which such student will not any ordinary course do and which has the effects of causing or generating a sense of authority or superiority by a student shame or torment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing of power. It is hereby notified for information of all concerned that in view of the judgement order dated 11.02.2009 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of the University of Kerala V/s the council of Principals of College in Kerala and others, if any incident of ragging comes to the notice of Anti Ragging Committee the accused students will be given an opportunity to explain and if his / her explanation is not satisfactory the college authority would expel him / her from the college.
